An easy one hour paddle to Naylor Boat Ramp, or six hours past multiple rapids, cut-throughs, and creeks: you choose. You'll see more houses downstream than upstream, but there is plenty of wild river, birds, fish, turtles, and maybe a gator. Avoid hunting season.

Statenville, GA, USGS Gauge 02317500:

78.1' (**2.0'**) lowest boatable 85.1' (9.0') highest safe

- 1.17 miles, 30.92507, -83.03867, **Naylor Park Beach**, r
- 1.25 miles, 30.924431, -83.037339, US 84 Bridge

Right and left bank (r or l) facing downstream.

- 1.29 miles, 30.924094, -83.036864, CSX RR Bridge, historic Atlantic & Coast Line RR, caused Troupville to move to Valdosta
- Just below RR bridge, r, house sites on Lake Alapaha
- 2.24 miles, 30.918022, -83.036568, *River Run Waterfall* drops 3 to 8 feet at low water. Many rapids nearby, dangerous even for the experienced
- 4.57 miles, 30.903923, -83.020189, *Foreman Creek* 03110202000597, 1, comes down across US 84
- 5.38 miles, 30.8928264, -83.0215647, **Reedy Creek** 00321455, l, from beyond Stockton
- 5.73 miles, 30.88913, -83.02319, **Reedy Creek Sandbars**, string of sandbars, l&r, good lunch stop; beware chiggers
- 7.42 miles, 30.87356, -83.0229, *Hairpin Willows*
- 7.60 miles, 30.8728313, -83.0232544, *Hairpin High-water*
