The US Air Force invites you to a "Virtual" Public Hearing for the Comprehensive Airspace Initiative for Moody Air Force Base

What: US Air Force Virtual Public Hearing.

The US Air Force is holding a virtual public hearing for the public to learn about and submit verbal comments on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Comprehensive Airspace Initiative for Moody Air Force Base (AFB), Georgia. The hearing will be held virtually, rather than in person, due to the COVID-19 emergency.

When: Thursday, October 29, 2020; 5:30 p.m. to 8 p.m.

The virtual public hearing room will open at 5:15 p.m. to allow attendees time to dial-in, register into the queue for making a public comment, and access the online presentation (if also viewing). At 5:30 p.m., the hearing will be called to order and start with a presentation by the Air Force. Following the presentation, the public will be invited to provide formal comments beginning at approximately 6 p.m. The hearing will conclude at 8 p.m., if not ended sooner by the hearing officer for lack of public participation. Why: The US Air Force has developed a Draft EIS and is seeking your input.

The Draft EIS addresses the proposal to configure new low-altitude Military Operations Areas (MOAs) beneath existing mid-altitude Special Use Airspace within the Moody Airspace Complex in Georgia. The proposal would modify the current training airspace structure by creating additional low-altitude MOAs and lowering the floor of existing airspace. The Proposed Action would not change the lateral dimensions of any existing airspace.

Where and How: Via Teleconference and Webex Online Meeting

Teleconference: To participate in the meeting by telephone, which will allow you to hear the presentation and make a verbal comment, call 844-992-4726 and enter the Meeting Number: 126 002 0391. When the public hearing enters the comment session, you can virtually raise your hand to enter the comment queue by pressing *3 on your telephone keypad. Note: All audio for the hearing is provided via phone.
