OPPORTUNITIES

• The first impression and overall attractiveness of many of VLPRA's parks has the potential to be enhanced through comprehensive park improvements, such as the updating, repair, and replacement of aging or damaged landscaping, hardscaping, amenities, and facilities. Chitty Park, Vallotton Big Field, and most of the VLPRA's boat ramps are examples of parks with a first impression and overall attractiveness hindered by hardscaping, landscaping, and park amenities that are in need of repair and replacement. Improving these elements would enhance the overall experience, perceived safety, and use of parks. Improving the frequency of maintenance to the exterior of many of the VLPRA's parks would also enhance the overall first impression and perceived management and stewardship of the parks.
