We would like to inform you of our request for a one-time Temporary Authorization to perform additional site investigation at a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) regulated unit. Specifically, the proposed effort includes installing soil borings through a RCRA-regulated unit cap to enable the collection of soil samples beneath the cap and above the water table, followed by source removal within the regulated unit by excavation and removal of impacted soil from underneath the concrete cap.
