Salt Mine. The Levy County Planning Commission packet didn't mention that the site for the 3RT Sand Mine is in the springshed of Rainbow Springs. Ther BOCC had no Public Hearing this month, because the applicant asked to delay indefinitely.

Right to Clean Water. Florida registered voters, please sign and circulate the petition.

Sewage. After its July 6th 194,251-gallon major sewage spill into Knights Creek above the Alapahoochee and Alapaha Rivers, Valdosta waited four days before sending a report to GA-EPD, and another day before telling the public. Valdosta's downstream water quality test results were too high a week later, yet the city stopped testing. Suwannee Riverkeeper met with the Valdosta City Manager and Assistant CM about sewage and trash. The announcement later that day of a third spill was one day after it was discovered at Hightower Creek; that is faster. Quitman a major spill, July 11th, into Okapilco Creek above the Withlacoochee River. Ashburn spilled 300,000 gallons into Ashburn Branch above the Little River on June 22, not reported until July 12.

Water Quality Testing. Sugar Creek continues to have E. coli, downstream of Valdosta's Hightower Creek sewage spill. Thanks to Michael and Jacob Bachrach for years of testing. New testers, please apply: https://wwals.net/?p=47084

Trash. Thanks to Valdosta Mayor Scott James Matheson for helping WWALS clean up the WIthlacoochee River, and to Utilities Assistant Director Jason Barnes for warning us about high E. coli, so we changed from a paddle to an on-land cleanup. That stretch was much cleaner than a year ago because of Valdosta trash traps and Russell Allen McBride cleaning out the one at Sugar Creek. More are needed, at Three Mile Branch and in Langdale Park. Plus city code enforcement upstream at parking lots and dumpsters.

Water Trails. GA-EPD asked if we wanted to request redesignating the rest of the Withlacoochee River downstream from GA 37 from Fishing to Recreation. If they do it, that will add stricter contamination limits. GDOT is widening Lakeland Highway south of Grand Bay. Added 24 Lanier EMA Markers to ARWT. Added Coffee Shoals to WLRWT. The Mozell Spells slot machines were popular.

<u>Troupville River Camp and Nature Park.</u> One Valdosta-Lowndes Executive Director Mary Beth Brownlee and Suwannee Riverkeeper attended a required webinar for the Georgia Outdoor Stewardship Program grants.
