- (a) There is induced movement of a contamination plume or the alteration of the rate or direction of the movement of a contamination plume towards an OFS or its spring run.
 - (b) Dewatering discharges cause harmful water quality impacts to the OFS or its spring run.
- (c) Withdrawals cause an increase in total dissolved solids (TDS) or chloride concentrations that detrimentally affects the OFS or its spring run.
- (d) Hydrologic alterations to the spring cause adverse impacts to the aquatic or wetland dependent flora or fauna in the spring.
- (e) Hydrologic alterations to the spring decrease flow rates of downgradient watercourses that cause adverse impacts to aquatic or wetland dependent flora or fauna.
