Rezonings. On September 12th <u>the Lowndes County Commission unanimously denied</u> a rezoning that <u>WWALS and many others</u> opposed on Quarterman Road in an agricultural and forestry area. This is the third such rezoning denial in two years.

Okefenokee NWR as UNESCO World Heritage Site. The <u>U.S. Department of the Interior on September 22 filed a notice</u> that it is asking ONWR to draft a nomination for itself. WWALS <u>has supported this</u> for years.

Strip mine near the Okefenokee. After Suwannee Riverkeeper presented it in August, on September 11th the Clinch County Commission passed a resolution opposing the strip mine and supporting the Okefenokee Swamp, including the UNESCO World Heritage Site bid. This follows Echols County on August 3rd and Valdosta on September 11, 2021. WWALS members are working on more to add to those passed by other counties and cities. Clinch County also set aside \$50,000 as a cash match for a grant for a Dark Sky Observatory on the Suwannee River in the county.

Sewage. Adel had two small sewage spills during Hurricane Idalia. Valdosta and Quitman had none.

Water Quality Testing. September started filthy upstream and ended mostly clean. A record six new testers trained by Gretchen Quarterman joined: Debbie Smith, Little River @ 122 - Folsom Bridge; Joanne Tremblay, Santa Fe River; Kristin Rubin, Santa Fe River; Treva Ellison, Bear Creek (Adel) and Little River near Reed Bingham SP; Russ Tatum, Withlacoochee at his property FL 6; Reina Lingle, Suwannee downstream at Branford and Royal Springs. <u>Grants Committee</u>. Suwannee Riverkeeper John S. Quarterman <u>presented slides</u> to the Suwannee-Satilla Regional Water Planning Council about an application with Valdosta State University Geosciences Professor Can Denizman for a GA-EPD Seed Grant to find and fix contamination sources upstream from Valdosta on the Withlacoochee River, Cat Creek, plus the Alapaha River.

SRWMD. Send your comments on the North Florida Regional Water Supply Plan by October 6th.

Trash. We sent Valdosta two trash trap vendor quotes on August 24th. Since Hurricane Idalia, we have heard nothing back.

<u>Troupville River Camp and Nature Park.</u> One Valdosta-Lowndes is in organizational and fundraising mode. No GOSP grant application this year.

PR Committee. Suwannee Riverkeeper was on WKUB FM twice, and talk921.com once, about WWALS River Revue and Okefenokee.
