Archaeological Opportunities on the Withlacoochee

- 1. Numerous Paleo and Archaic Sites abundant spring sites first and second magnitude frequent quarry sites and lithic scatter, deep "lakes" may have preserved evidence of early humans, flora and fauna not just "stones and bones"
- 2. Fish Weirs and the possibility of documenting earlier harvesting cycles
- 3. One (and possibly other) Spanish mission sites could illuminate life in the "fringe" missions away from the Camino Real
- 4. Nineteenth and early Twentieth Century sites all relatively unstudied
- 5. Naval Stores and Timber Industries numerous sites
- 6. Drew/Bucki Mill Site several puzzling features
