## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 3 of Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to surface mining, so as to provide for a five-year moratorium on the
- 3 acceptance of applications for new permits and the acceptance of requests to modify existing
- 4 permits by the Environmental Protection Division of the Department of Natural Resources
- 5 to expand the area of land affected by surface mining operations on Trail Ridge; to provide
- 6 a definition; to provide exemptions; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 7 and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 Part 3 of Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 11 relating to surface mining, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 12 "12-4-85.
- 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'Trail Ridge' means the elevated, geological
- 14 <u>feature bounded on the west by the Okefenokee Swamp and its watershed; on the east by</u>
- an elevation of 100 feet above mean sea level; on the south by the triple divide of the
- Soldiers Camp Island, Boone Creek, and Barbar Branch watersheds; and on the north by
