- disasters. Assure enforcement of all existing building and land development regulations. The Building Official and/or the Floodplain Administrator is responsible for implementing and administrating the mitigation project, including researching and identifying funding sources and providing timeframes for the completion of the project.
- Bradford County School District The School District is responsible for construction and maintenance of public schools used as emergency shelters. The School District will be responsible for implementation of mitigation actions proposed for public school buildings. The School District Superintendent is responsible for implementing and administrating the mitigation project, including researching and identifying funding sources and providing timeframes for the completion of the project.
- Bradford County Public Works Provide technical assistance and advice on identifying
  and accomplishing mitigation actions to improve the design, construction and placement
  of roads, bridges, culverts, etc., that will eliminate or lessen the impact of disasters. The
  Public Works Director is responsible for implementing and administrating the mitigation
  project, including researching and identifying funding sources and providing timeframes
  for the completion of the project.
- Florida Forest Service Provide technical assistance and advice on all aspects of wildfire
  issues including identification and accomplishment of mitigation actions designed to
  reduce the loss of life and real property. The Florida Forest Service is responsible for
  implementing and administrating the mitigation project, including researching and
  identifying funding sources and providing timeframes for the completion of the project.
- Florida Department of Transportation Provide technical assistance and advice on identifying and accomplishing mitigation actions to improve the design, construction and placement of roads, bridges, culverts, etc., that will eliminate or lessen the impact of disasters. The FDOT District Roadway Engineer for the area is responsible for implementing and administrating the mitigation project, including researching and identifying funding sources and providing timeframes for the completion of the project.
- Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) Provide technical assistance and funding when available; in all aspects of emergency management in order to better able the county to prepare for, respond to, recover from, and mitigate against natural, technological and man-made hazards.
- Suwannee River Water Management District (SWRMD) Provide technical assistance
  and advice on identifying and accomplishing mitigation actions to help reduce or
  eliminate the impact of flooding in the County. The SRWMD Representative is
  responsible for implementing and administrating the mitigation project, including
  researching and identifying funding sources and providing timeframes for the completion
  of the project.
