Great Promise Partnership Program Funding

Funding will be used to hire high school students who are eligible participants in the Great Promise Partnership Program. These positions will provide part-time employment hours during the school year and full-time employment hours during summer. (\$50,000) *National Objective is to benefit low to moderate income persons*

Back to School Book Bag Giveaway

The City will hold its Annual Book Bag community event that will supply low-to moderate income families with supplies needed for educational purposes. (\$10,000)

National Objective is to benefit low- and moderate-income persons and an area benefit for low – moderate income populations

Neighborhood Action Associations (NAAs)

Funding will be used to assist residents of the neighborhoods in the Designated Revitalization Area (DRA) of the City of Valdosta with organizing formal neighborhood associations. This funding will be limited to \$500 per recognized group for centralized community information systems only (neighborhood boards or hubs). (\$1,500)
