But for the failure of the Administrator to promulgate new and revised numerical water quality criteria for priority toxic pollutants to protect human health and the designated uses of Florida's Class II, III and III-Limited waters (e.g., shellfish harvesting and fish consumption), Waterkeepers Florida would not have established its Priority Toxics Training Program and would not have diverted funds intended to be used for its Capacity program to the Priority Toxics Training Program.

47. If the Administrator promulgates new and revised numerical water quality criteria for priority toxic pollutants to protect human health and the designated uses of Florida's Class II, III and III-Limited waters (e.g., shellfish harvesting and fish consumption), Waterkeepers Florida will terminate its Priority Toxics Training Program and cease to divert funds for its Capacity program to the Priority Toxics Training Program.

48.
